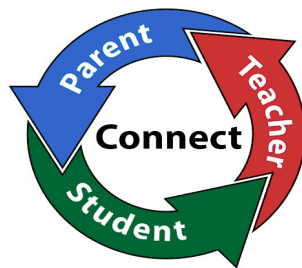


What is the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA)?
